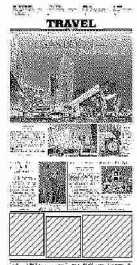

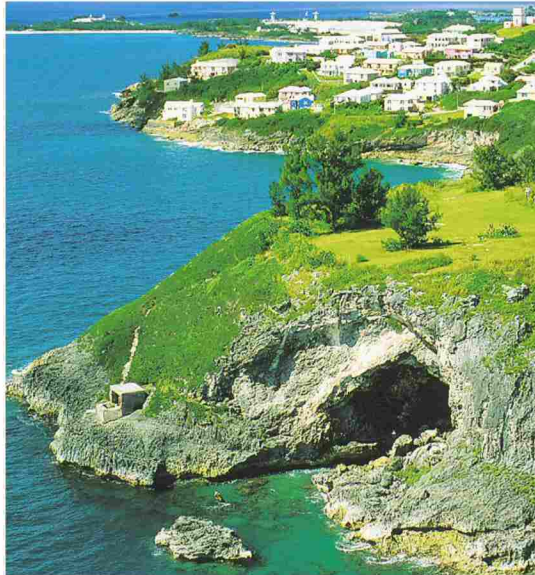
\$40 A NIGHT AT ALA MOANA HOTEL
